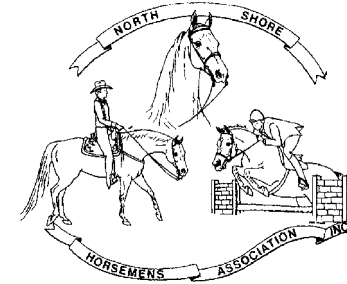

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES: Noted in prize list by each class.
2. Judges' decisions are final.
3. The Show Management reserves the right to further cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
4. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current NEHC & NHH&TA Rule Books and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
5. In classes where judging standards are listed, they are named in order of importance.
6. NSHA MEMBERSHIP: NSHA Annual Award points accrue at each horse show for NSHA members. In performance classes, the owner/leasee of the horse must be a member, and in equitation classes, the rider must be a member. In addition, a lease form must be on file with NSHA. No points are to count until membership is paid. Membership applications are available from the Show Secretary the day of the show or by writing to NSHA, PO Box 635, Byfield, MA 01922.
7. Trophy and/or cash plus 6 ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted. ***PRIZE MONEY WILL BE APPLIED TO ENTRIES***.
8. Entries close the day before the show. Post entries will be charged a fee of \$10.00 for the day. No telephone calls will be accepted after 4:00pm.
9. **THE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT NOT TO DELAY CLASSES due to conflicts and not to allow substitution of classes or horses.** No ring holds will be accepted for coaching conflicts between rings.
10. Current negative Coggins Test is required.
11. Any entry found on the Judge's card that has not been previously entered may be required to pay one and one half entry fee.
12. All returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 fee, and entrants will not be allowed to compete unless all previous indebtedness to NSHA has been cleared. Any individual or farm that has two returned checks within one calendar year will be required to pay for entries by cash or bank check/money order for the remainder of the year.
13. Refunds of entry fees will not be made unless a veterinarian or doctor's certificate of lameness, injury or illness is shown. Refunds will be made if a class is cancelled.
14. Every animal entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Committee, but the NSHA show and its employees will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall sign the entry blank holding the show blameless for any loss, accident or decision which may occur.
15. NHHT&A will support the USEF and NEHC and/or any affiliated state organization in any disciplinary action against exhibitors that involve sportsmanship or the good conduct of shows or indebtedness and will extend these actions to all NHH&TA affiliated shows.

NSHA MEMBERSHIP & AWARDS INFORMATON

North Shore Horsemen's Association, Inc. is a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting interest and education in horsemanship. To this end, we offer this series of Hunter and Pleasure horse shows with year-end awards in over 65 divisions with many special awards. We also award two \$500.00 scholarships each year.

RULES FOR ANNUAL PLEASURE AWARDS

1. All horses/ponies competing in performance classes must be owned or leased by a member, whose current dues are paid, in order to accumulate points. In addition, leased horses/ponies must have a current NSHA lease form on file with the NSHA in order to accumulate points. All exhibitors competing in equitation classes must be members whose current dues are paid, in order to accumulate points. Points for the NSHA Annual Awards will accrue only from the time membership dues are RECEIVED by the Show Secretary, Membership Secretary or Treasurer. NOTE: Children of Family Memberships must adhere to the rules of the USEF regarding Junior status.
2. Riders in all events, unless otherwise specified, may be either amateur or professional and are eligible for points, provided their current dues are paid.
3. Points to be accumulated only during N.S.H.A. sponsored point shows according to published schedule.
4. There will be championship trophy, reserve ribbon, and third, fourth, fifth and sixth place ribbons presented to the competitors accumulating the most points in each respective division at the end of the season.
5. In order for a class or division to be eligible for an Annual Award, it must have been offered and run in one more than half the number of shows offered.
6. Each competing horse, pony, or rider (in equitation classes) must show in the SAME point class in at least ONE MORE show than HALF the number of point shows offered and run to be eligible for Annual Awards. Example: If five (5) shows are offered and run, one must compete in at least three (3). Exception: If Management cancels a show after it has begun, then the horse/pony or rider will still receive credit for attendance at that show, provided they have completed an entry form and a number has been assigned. Limited Equitation/Pleasure: Any rider qualifying out of a limited equitation or pleasure division/class (examples: maiden equitation, novice equitation, limit equitation, novice rider pleasure) shall receive their accrued year-end points in that division/class, provided they continue to compete in at least one more than half the number of point shows offered and run as described above.
7. It will be the duty of the Show Committee to determine the eligibility of all competitors.
8. Questions and protests will be referred to the Show Committee whose decision is final.
9. Points will be scored as follows, regardless of Show Classification:

OPEN HORSE COLTS AND FILLIES

NEHC "AA"/NHH&TA "A"

Open to horse, colts and fillies only (pony colts and fillies not eligible) that are under 2 years of age as of previous January 1st. Foaling date must be stated on entry form. No more than 2 attendants per entry allowed in ring. The use of any whip over 6' by handler or assistant is prohibited. Dams not allowed in ring at any time.

1. OPEN HORSE COLTS AND FILLIES

Entries to be shown in a suitable bridle or halter. Required to move individually at a trot or alternate gait both ways of ring. To be judged on quality, conformation, way of going and soundness.

2. OPEN HORSE COLTS AND FILLIES CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE

Specifications same as Horse Colts and Fillies. Must have entered and completed Class 1.

**CLASSICS
(UNRATED)**

Entry Fee: \$25.00

25. CLASSIC - One Classic per show (with the exception of show 5) in the order listed below. Double NSHA points to be awarded. Winners must choose which pleasure class his/her points will count toward before the end of the show day. There must be 4 entries to run the class.

1st show Open English Pleasure - Open to horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. To be required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and substance.

2nd show Open Western Pleasure - Open to horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. To be required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and substance.

3rd show Junior Pleasure Classic – 18 and under. Open to horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes, rider to be 18 years of age or under. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. To be required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and substance.

4th show Walk-Trot Beginner Pleasure 10 & under Classic - Riders to show at a walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. May be asked to back. Jodhpurs/breeches/chaps and boots are required. **Stallions are barred.** Judged on manners, suitability of horse to rider & performance.

5th show Walk-Trot over 11 Classic - Open to amateur riders 11 years through adult, riding in any seat. Riders to show at a walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. May be asked to back. Jodhpurs/breeches/chaps and boots are required. **Stallions are barred.** Judged on manners, suitability of horse to rider & performance.

5th show Hunter Classic - Open to horses of a hunter type. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. . To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.



NSHA OPEN EQUITATION MEDAL

Unrated NEHC & NHH&TA

27. NSHA OPEN EQUITATION MEDAL. Open to all junior and amateur MEMBERS of the North Shore Horsemen’s Association. Open to all seats: (Hunt Seat, Stock Seat & Saddle Seat) All contestants are to show at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. They will also be asked to complete a pattern. To fill a class, 3 competitors must show and be judged with proper appointments. To qualify for the finals, to be held at the last NSHA Pleasure Show, on September 21, 2008, the rider must have won one blue ribbon, or accrued 8 points.

76. HUNTER PLEASURE

Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse’s mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

To be shown on reasonably loose rein without loss of contact at flat-footed walk, trot, extended trot, canter & hand gallop. Must stand quietly & back readily. To be judged on performance, substance & manners.

Specifications same as Road Hack. Must have entered and completed class 28.

48. APPALOOSA HALTER

Exhibitor may show in English or Western attire. Entries to be shown in a suitable bridle or halter. Entries to be judged individually, standing, and ten at a walk and trot on the line. Horses should stand squarely and naturally and are not to be stretched. Horses to be handled and shown by one person only. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, action, substance, quality and manners. If entries warrant, classes may be divided by age: A. Age 2 and under, B. Age 3 and over. To be judged 40% on conformation, 20% on type, 20% on soundness, and 20% on action.

87. APPALOOSA WESTERN PLEASURE

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein. Exhibitors will be asked to extend the jog in at least one direction. The exhibitors will be asked to lope with a slight increase in forward motion. To be judged 60% on performance and manners, 30% on type and conformation, quality and substance and 10% on appointments. Silver not to count over a good working outfit. No martingales, tie downs or draw reins.

90. APPALOOSA WESTERN PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP

Specifications to be the same as qualifying class. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in class 87.

To be shown at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein. To be judged 60% on performance and manners, 30% on type and conformation, quality and substance and 10% on appointments. No martingales or draw reins.

56. APPALOOSA ENGLISH PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP

Specifications to be the same as qualifying class. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in qualifying in class 53.

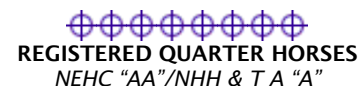

58. APPALOOSA PLEASURE JUNIOR TO RIDE

To be ridden by children under 18 years of age, No stallions allowed. Open to English and Western horses. If shown in a stock saddle, silver will not count over a good working outfit. No martingales, tie-downs or draw reins. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog, canter or lope, on a reasonably loose rein, both ways of the ring. To be judged 60% on performance and manners, 30% on type, conformation, quality and substance, and 10% on appointments.

Horses must be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association. They must also be shown under their full registered name with papers available. All class specifications will be the same as the American Quarter Horse Association Specifications. EXCEPT: in Halter classes. Exhibitor may show in English or Western attire. Entries to be shown in a suitable bridle or halter. One handler may show only one horse in each class.

51. QUARTER HORSE HALTER, MARES

To be shown in hand at a walk and jog. To be judged on type, conformation, quality, substance and soundness. Heredity or transmissible unsoundness shall disqualify a horse.

52. QUARTER HORSE STALLIONS AND GELDING

Specifications same as class 51, Quarter Horse Halter, Mares.

60. QUARTER HORSE HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

Horses to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Horses should back easily and stand quietly. Horses may change gaits at the flat-footed walk or the trot at the judge's discretion. Light contact with the horse's mouth is recommended. At the option of the judge, all or just the top eight horses may be required to hand gallop, one or both ways of the ring. Never more than eight horses to hand gallop at one time. At hand gallop, the judge may ask the group to halt and stand quietly on a free rein (loosened rein).

61. QUARTER HORSE HUNTER UNDER SADDLE CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE unrated NEHC

Specifications same as Quarter Horse Hunter under Saddle. Must have entered and completed class 60.

86. QUARTER HORSE WESTERN PLEASURE

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. Horses shall not be asked to extend the lope, but at the discretion of judge, they may be asked to extend the jog. Horses are required to back easily & stand quietly. Horses are to be reversed to the inside (away from the rail). They may be required to reverse at the walk or jog at the discretion of the judge, but shall not be asked to reverse at the lope. Judge may ask for additional work of the same nature from any horse. He/she is not to ask for work other than that listed above. Class will be judged on the performance and conformation of the horse at the discretion of the judge. Entries will be penalized for excessive speed or being on wrong leads.

REGISTERED ARABIAN & HALF-ARABIAN HORSES
NEHC "B"/ NHH&T A "A"

Horses shown in this division must be registered with the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., and/or Canadian Arabian Horse Registry. Must be entered under their full registered name, or if under age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for. Half-Arabian horses must be registered with the International Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian and/or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or be eligible for registry and registration applied for, and must be entered under their full registered name.

33. HALF-ARABIAN ENGLISH PLEASURE - OPEN

Open to mares and geldings only. To be shown with an English-type saddle, no forward seat saddles allowed. Informal saddle seat attire is required, no hunt attire allowed. To be shown at a walk, normal trot, strong trot, canter and hand gallop. To be judged on manners, performance, attitude, quality and conformation.

37. HALF-ARABIAN ENGLISH PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE

Specifications same as Half Arabian English Pleasure - Open, except to be judged on manners, performance, attitude, quality, conformation and presence. Must have entered and competed in class 33.

If shown with a stock saddle, silver will not count over a good working outfit.No martingales, tie downs or draw reins. To be judged on manners, performance, substance and conformation.

29. JUNIOR EXHIBITOR HACK

Open to horses and ponies. To be shown under English tack and rider must be under 18 years of age. To be shown at a work, trot and canter on a reasonably loose rein, but without loss of contact. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality.
 Entry Fee: \$20.00 Trophy

36. JUNIOR EXHIBITOR HACK CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE

Specifications same as Junior Exhibitor's Hack. Must have entered and shown in class 29.

Open to Palominos, Buckskins, Appaloosa, Paints and Pintos. May be shown under English or Western tack.

49. OPEN COLOR BREED MODEL

Open to Palominos, Buckskins, Appaloosa, Paints and Pinto horses and ponies. Must be shown in a bridle or show halter. Not to be moved. To be judged on conformation, substance, quality, manners, and as the best color example of the particular breed.
 Entry Fee: \$20.00 Trophy

74. OPEN COLOR BREED PLEASURE

To be shown at a walk, trot or jog, and canter or lope. Must stand quietly & back readily. To be judged on performance and best color example of the particular breed.
 Entry Fee: \$20.00 Trophy

77. OPEN COLOR BREED PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE

Specifications same as Open Color Breed Pleasure. Must have entered and competed in class 74.
 Entry Fee; \$25.00 \$25, \$20, \$16, \$14



LEADLINE

Riders may not compete in any other under saddle class at the same show. An adult shall be required to lead entry. Handlers and riders should be properly attired. Child must be able to ride unassisted. Classes will be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. Suitability of rider to mount to count.

6. LEADLINE EQUITATION - 5 YEARS & UNDER unrated NEHC/NHH&T A

To be judged at the walk ONLY on the line and may be asked to back. To be judged on equitation only. May also enter class 7 but not class 5.

5. LEADLINE EQUITATION - 8 YEARS & UNDER unrated NEHC/rated NHH&T A "A"

SPONSORED BY WHITE PICKET FARM/KIM CARLTON
 To be judged at a walk and trot on the line both ways of the ring. To be judged on equitation only. May also enter class 7 but not class 6.
 Entry Fee: \$12.00 Trophy

7. LEADLINE SUITABILITY 8 YEARS & UNDER unrated NEHC/NHH&T A

To be judged at the walk AND trot or jog. Riders 5 & under may walk only if desired. To be judged on the horse/pony as a pleasure class with suitability to mount emphasized.
 Entry Fee: \$12.00 Trophy

8. LEADLINE SUITABILITY CHAMPIONSHIP unrated NEHC/NHH&T A

To enter, must have entered and shown in Class 7. To be judged at the walk AND trot or jog. Riders 5 & under may walk only if desired. To be judged on the horse/pony as a pleasure class with suitability to mount emphasized.
 Entry Fee: \$15.00 Trophy

PLEASURE HORSES (cont'd)

23. LADIES OPEN PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP **unrated NEHC/NHH&TA "A"**
Specifications to be the same as qualifying class. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in class 21.
