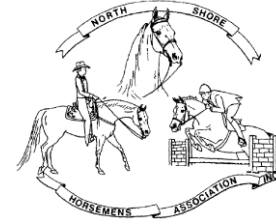

### **Directions:**

**Twisdenwood Farm, 240 Andover Street, Georgetown, MA 01833**

**From Route 95 South** take exit 53B (Route 97-Georgetown). Continue on Route 97 for approximately 4 miles until you come to your first set of traffic lights( gas station will be on your right). At this light, take a left and bear left onto Route 133 West. Follow 133 west for approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile. Twisdenwood is at the top of the hill on your left

**From Route 95 North** take exit 54, Route 133 west, Georgetown, Go 1.5 miles to light in Georgetown center. Take left at light to continue on Route 133 West. Route 133 West bears off to the right almost immediately after the turn. Stay on Route 133 west for 1 mile and farm entrance is on the left.

**From Route 495S** - take exit 43 (Mass Ave Exit). Bear right off the ramp and follow to the intersection of Route 125/133. At the light take a left and follow 133/125 for approximately 4-5 miles. You will come to a light with a Chinese restaurant on the left. Go through the light and take your next right (staying on Route 133 east). Follow for approximately 6-8 miles. The farm is on your right just after the Georgetown Golf Club.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT  
2010

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulting or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees, and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors, and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of an in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR1502.5.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. ENTRY FEES: \$20.00 Regular Classes, \$25.00 Stakes Classes, and \$30.00 for Medal Classes unless otherwise noted
2. Judges' decisions are final.
3. Any division with over 40 entries will be divided, with prize monies doubled. The Show Management reserves the right to further cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
4. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Classes not covered by USEF. rules to be run under the rules of the NEHC & MHC. USEF rules take precedence over rules of other organizations.
5. NSHA MEMBERSHIP: NSHA Annual Awards points accrue at each horse show for NSHA members. In performance classes, the owner/lessee of the horse must be a member, and in equitation classes, the rider must be a member. In addition, a NSHA lease form must be on file for all leased horses. Points will NOT count until membership is paid. Membership applications are available from the Show Secretary the day of the show or by writing to Mary Lynne Rahlson, 9 Flume Street, Concord, NH 03303 or visiting our website: [www.northshorehorsemens.org](http://www.northshorehorsemens.org)
6. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness, unless otherwise noted. Championship and reserve ribbons in each division will be awarded in accordance with USEF rules.
7. Trophy and/or cash plus 8 ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted. Prize money must be awarded at the Show Secretary's stand when entries are completely paid and MUST be picked up by the end of the show day. Prize money checks must be cashed within 30 days. **Prizes awarded in classes with 3 or more entries.**
8. To be eligible for stake classes, entrants must have shown in one other class in the same division. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of entry fee and any prize awarded.
9. Courses consist of post and rails, walls, gates, pickets and brush fences.
10. Entries close the day before the show. Post entries will be charged a fee of \$10.00 for the day. No telephone calls will be accepted after 4:00 p.m.
11. Current negative Coggins Test is required.
12. All returned checks will be charged a \$30.00 fee, and entrants will not be allowed to compete unless all previous indebtedness to NSHA has been cleared. Any person or farm with more than two returned checks within a calendar year will be required to pay all fees by money order or cash for the balance of the year.
13. Refunds of entry fees will not be made unless a veterinarian or doctor's certificate of lameness, injury, or illness is shown. Refunds will be made if a class is cancelled.
14. Every animal entered for competition will be under control of the Horse Show Committee, but the NSHA show and its employees will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall sign the entry blank holding the show, USEF, and NEHC blameless for any loss, accident or decision which may occur.

One or more individual tests may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-15). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course

16. MHC HUNTER SEAT MEDAL Entry fee \$30.00  
Open to Junior members of the MHC who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'0". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-18). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course.
17. NEHC HUNTER SEAT MEDAL Entry fee \$30.00  
Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. All competitors required to perform over at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-18). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

18. SHOW CIRCUIT MAGAZINE CHILDREN'S MEDAL Entry fee \$30.00  
Open to Junior members of the American Horse Shows Association or CEF who have never competed in a National Equestrian Final with fences at 3'6" (i.e.: USEF. Medal, ASPCA Maclay, USET, CET or CEF Finals, WIHS Capital Cup). All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. The top 4 riders, or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF tests 1-19. An open numerical scoring system will be used in the first round.

19. MHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER SEAT MEDAL Entry fee \$30.00  
*SPONSORED BY CORNERSTONE FARM, HAVERHILL, MA*  
Open to Amateur Adult members of MHC. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6" to 2'9", with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF. tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

20. ARIAT NATIONAL ADULT MEDAL Entry fee \$30.00  
Open to all members of the USEF or CEF who are eligible to compete in the Amateur Adult Hunter division at this show. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. The course may be either a hunter or jumper type course. The top 4 riders, or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF tests 1-19. An open numerical scoring system will be used in the first round.

21. NEHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER SEAT MEDAL Entry fee \$30.00  
*SPONSORED BY EXCLUSIVE EQUESTRIAN SERVICES/DENISE NEAN-RAYMOND*  
Open to Amateur Adult members of the New England Horsemen's Council. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'0". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

### 74. NSHA Short Stirrup Equitation Medal (18")

Open to members of NSHA who are 12 years of age and under. Rider is not to compete in any other class that requires jumping fences any higher than 18". One or more tests of the top four competitors may be required at the discretion of the judge. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. Rider must win one blue or accrue one blue.

A Show Manager may divide on day of show into Small/Medium Pony and Large Pony Hunter if there are sufficient entries. Fences for Small Ponies shall be as follows: Ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands – 2'3", Ponies over 12.2 hands, but not exceeding 13.2 hands – 2'6", Large Ponies (over 13.2 hands but not exceeding 14.2 hands) – 3'. MANNERS AND SUITABILITY OF PONY FOR THE RIDER SHALL BE EMPHASIZED AND EXTREME SPEED SHALL BE PENALIZED. The suggested distance for an In-Out when used in a ring for small ponies is 20", medium ponies –22" and large –24". Shall be judged on performance and soundness.

**24. GRANITE STATE 18" NOVICE MEDAL:** Fences not to exceed 18" Junior and adult riders who have not shown over 18" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Children's Medal or the Granite State Modified Adult Medal depending upon riders age during the competition year..

**25. GRANITE STATE CHILDREN'S MEDAL:** Fences not to exceed 2'3" Junior riders who have not shown over 2'6" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Junior Medal.

**26. GRANITE STATE PONY MEDAL:** Fences not to exceed 2'3" for small & medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals two (2) consecutive years, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Junior Medal.

**27. GRANITE STATE 2'3" MODIFIED AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL.** Fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown over 2'6" at a recognized show. Must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals two (2) consecutive years, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Adult Medal.

**28. GRANITE STATE ADULT MEDAL.** Fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals, but may return the following year.

**29. GRANITE STATE JUNIOR MEDAL.** Fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year-end finals, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in this class and must move up to the Granite State Adult Medal once they reach the age requirement.
